August 6, 2013



Chairperson Fred Albertz called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. In attendance: Trustees: Fred Albertz and Steven Wollin. Rory Holland was absent and excused. Also in attendance: Village Trustee Tim Semo and Administrator Mark Johnsrud.

Statement of public notice - This meeting was posted and noticed according to law.

Public Comment (limit two minutes per person) - None

Approve Minutes of April 22, 2013

A Wollin/Albertz motion carried unanimously to approve the minutes of April 22, 2013.

Discussion and Recommendation – Placement - No Trucks Signage – Village Walk Lane

Administrator Johnsrud explained that a temporary “No Trucks Beyond This Point” sign has been placed on Village Walk Lane from just south of the south driveway into Kwik Trip to the cul de sac. Semi-truck traffic turning around within the cul de sac has damaged the new pavement. The pavement was repaired by the Jefferson County Highway Department.

A Wollin/Albertz motion carried unanimously to permanently place a “No Trucks Beyond this Point” sign on the south end of Village Walk Lane at a location to be determined by the Street Superintendent and the Village Administrator.

Discussion and Recommendation – Placement - Neighborhood Watch Signage – Chapel Hill

Chapel Hill Homeowner Association President Tim Semo spoke in favor of the placement of two Neighborhood Crime Watch signs on the same posts that have “Slow – Children at Play” signage on Chapel Hill Drive and Gosdeck Lane. The members of the Chapel Hill Homeowners’ Association voted in favor of the placement of these signs.

A Wollin/Albertz motion carried unanimously to approve the placement of two Neighborhood Crime Watch signs on Chapel Hill Drive and Gosdeck Lane.

Discussion and Recommendation – Removal of No Parking Signage- Kensington Circle and Coventry Circle.

Johnsrud explained that “No Parking This Side of Street” signage was placed by the developer of the Tanner Ridge subdivision on Kensington Circle and Coventry Circle, however, the Village never adopted this no parking zone by ordinance. Currently, the residents of Tanner Ridge do not want parking restrictions on Kensington Circle or Coventry Circle. Staff recommendation is to remove the signage and permit parking on Kensington Circle and Coventry Circle.

A Wollin/Albertz motion carried unanimously to remove “No Parking” signs on Kensington Circle and Coventry Circle.
