

Tree Care Tips:

Transplanting trees causes stress, which can permanently impair a tree's long-term health. A little tender loving care will go a long way toward ensuring your new tree will survive and thrive!

- 1) Give the tree a good soaking (provide a trickle of water around the root ball for about an hour) two or three times a week until the first freeze.
- 2) The use of a stimulator such as Superthrive is encouraged to promote root growth.
- 3) It is advisable to maintain the mulch around the base of the tree for at least the next decade. Mulch absorbs water when it rains and holds the moisture in the ground to nourish the tree for days and weeks after rains have stopped. The wider around the tree the mulch, the more effective it is.
- 4) Water transplanted trees, especially for the first three years after they have been transplanted, once the spring rains have stopped and the weather turns dry. Give each tree a good soaking (5 gallons or more of water) every week or two during the dry months of July and August, and into September, if necessary.
