



General Order Number 15

Johnson Creek Fire & EMS Department

Effective July 9, 2012

EMS Priorities;

1. Medic Unit 703 is to be stationed in the Village of Johnson Creek at all times awaiting ALS emergency calls for service in our fire district or for mutual aid calls in other districts. This order precludes any such "move-up" to another district's quarters as may be requested within the State of Wisconsin MABAS system. However, Medic/Rescue Unit 704 may be called for "move-ups".
2. Upon the receipt of an emergency call for vehicle accidents any medic/rescue unit shall respond without delay to the scene of the accident. Personnel shall provide an "on air" radio size-up of the situation found and direct incoming units of their needs. Safety of all personnel is paramount and the first arriving fire officer will become the incident commander.
3. At all emergency scenes where a fire officer is present, they shall become the incident commander. All requests for additional resources by EMS personnel shall go through the incident commander.
4. Medic units shall assist with incident rehab by providing creature comforts, replacement fluids, and medical assessments. Medic Unit 703 may be called to another emergency at which time Medic/Rescue Unit 704 will retain all rehab responsibilities.

This order will take effect and be in force on and after 0700 hours on the date indicated.
