Lock-Box Information;

The following vehicles have lock-box keys secured in combination boxes;

Medic Unit 703, Rescue Unit 704, Engine 21, Engine 22, Command Car

The fire station also has a lock-box on the outside of the building by the main door. Within this lock-box is the key to the all glass station door to be used by "move-up" resources in the MABAS system.

When our units are requested to "move-up" and occupy another fire district's quarters, the lock-box keys to those stations will be kept in the vehicle combination lock-box of the units listed above. When Tender 26 is requested to move-up the chief with the command car will need to exchange the key with the operator of T26.

This order will take effect and be in force on and after 0700 hours on the date indicated.
