Effective October 1, 2012

Whenever on-scene conditions dictate that an immediate evacuation of a building is needed the following protocol will be used;

3 short blasts, duration of 1 full second per blast, from vehicle air horns will indicate to all personnel within a troubled building that an immediate evacuation is required.

The procedure above is to be repeated twice.

This emergency protocol may be initiated by any personnel who deems a situation to be immediately unsafe and requiring all personnel to exit. Examples include; impending flashover or backdraft conditions, actual hostile fire events, impending building collapse or actual collapse of any building structure or part of a structure.

This order will take effect and be in force on and after 0700 hours on the date indicated.
