



## **General Order Number 35**

Johnson Creek Fire & EMS Department

### **Effective December 17, 2012**

Our first out engine will be Engine 21 to all structure fires, still alarms, single-engine responses, MABAS box alarms (including change of quarters), and mutual aid requests (including RIT response).

Engine 22 will only be the first out engine for known or suspected extrication emergencies.

Otherwise, Engine 21 will lead on all of our fire district emergencies, laying LDH supply lines into fire attack situations when necessary, with Engine 22 following. This configuration will allow the use of Engine 22's front suction when needed for water supply needs. For all MABAS requests, Engine 22 will remain in quarters in the event an engine is needed in our fire district.

This order will take effect and be in force on and after 0700 hours on the date indicated.
