### **Effective January 14, 2013**

Our department policy concerning fire training attendance is that personnel attend at least one fire training session per month and miss no more than 4 sessions in a row for an average of 12 sessions per year. Remember too that we have 3 fire training sessions per month set up for the second, third, and fourth Tuesdays each month from 6:30 to 9:00 PM. The first session is always classroom where we cover theory, SOG's, and problem solving. Session 2 and 3 are follow-up hands-on sessions that closely follow what was presented in Session 1.

Our department philosophy is that frequent and comprehensive fire training is paramount to safe and effective emergency response. Related to this philosophy is regular attendance. Our goal is that our fire training does not ever let any member down when faced with an emergency.

This order will take effect and be in force on and after 0700 hours on the date indicated.
