

VILLAGE BOARD UPDATES FOR MAY

On April 5, 2016 Steve Wollin, Laurie Adams, and Kelly Wollschlager were elected to the Village Board. Kelly Wollschlager was unable to fill his seat creating a vacancy on the Board. At the May 23, 2016 Village Board meeting Fred Albertz was selected among four candidates to fill the vacancy.

The revised site plan for Johnson Creek School District at 455 Aztalan Street was approved to include lighting and signage.

The Village Board approved to make the intersection of Union Street/Aztalan Street & Milwaukee Street an all way stop and mark the crossing to be a ladder style crosswalk pavement marking.

ELECTION INFORMATION: Election dates: **August 9 and November 8.** Voting hours are 7 am to 8 pm. State law now requires a valid Photo ID before you can vote. The ID needs to have your picture and current name but does not have to have your current address. This is different than the proof of residence. When registering to vote or changing a name and/or address you will need to provide proof of residence. You can register prior to election day by stopping at Village Hall Monday through Friday 8 am to 4 pm until Friday before the election or by mail until July 20 for the August Election.
