TRASH REMOVAL GUIDELINES FROM BADGERLAND

CHANGES FOR BULK PICKUP ON APRIL 10, 2020

"As a provider of waste disposal and sanitation services, Badgerland Disposal has been deemed an essential services provider and will continue providing services to help keep your community clean without interruption. With that said, our primary focus on the safety of our employees and your residents becomes more important than ever before, and some adjustments will be made.

*Badgerland Disposal **must cease collection of bulk waste items during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.** Our employees cannot collect any waste or recycling that is not containerized and placed in the appropriate Badgerland Disposal provided cart. Meaning, **loose items outside the cart cannot be collected for COVID-19 safety concerns.***

At Badgerland Disposal, safety is of utmost importance. The safety of our employees, our customers and public, override the risk of handling materials outside of containers. We are adjusting daily to mitigate the challenges COVID-19 is creating, which ultimately led to this difficult decision. Rest assured, we are prepared to continue providing our essential services to you and your residents. We will re-evaluate the temporary suspension of this service regularly over the coming weeks and keep you posted. " - **Kris Roesken, Director of Business**

- Potential for an additional supplementary bulk service date if required later this year
