A Badgerland dumpster will be placed at the Johnson Creek Compost Site for April's bulk garbage disposal. Beginning Friday, April 10th, residents will be able to utilize the dumpster to place ONE bulk item for this month's bulk pick up. The dumpster will be at the Compost Site through Sunday, April 12th , and residents are able to utilize the dumpster during the regular Compost Site hours:

**Friday, April 10: Noon – 2:30 p.m.**

**Saturday, April 11: 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.**

**Sunday, April 12: 11 a.m. – 4 p.m.**

The Village and Badgerland will continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation to keep employees and the Village safe. Should safety guidelines be needed in May, we will share that information with residents. Thank you for your cooperation.
