Grading Permit / Application
Required for Grading Projects in excess of 2,500 cu. ft.

Application must be accompanied by a grading plan showing existing and proposed grade contours, lot lines, material to be used for fill, all existing structures, direction storm water will flow, removal of trees and other vegetation. Erosion control measures, if required, must be in place prior to project start. Immediately after grading, *all* disturbed surfaces must be restored with topsoil (4" minimum), seeded, fertilized and mulched. All construction activities are to be initiated and finalized within 30 days of the start of land disturbing activities. The owner or contractor is to confirm the start of grading 24 hours in advance.
